Vivid On-the-Spot Learning Specialized Campuses

Dongduk Women's University pursues a 'University where learning can be a special experience'. A 'University where learning can be a special experience' needs student-focused services and an accommodating campus that provides students convenient access to information and freedom to move about.



◎ A Ubiquitous Campus

Women's University concluded a contract with Korea Telecom for the establishment of a U-campus and has begun construction of the U-campus. Once the system has been established, students will be able to manage their needs and exchange information anywhere, inside or outside of the campus, through their notebook computers, cell phones, PDAs, etc. A smart ID card has also been designed for ubiquitous services and contains numerous functions such as office access management, class attendance management, library access and seating management, book lending and return management, an electronic money card, locker access management, a rechargeable transportation card, and banking services.

◎ Specialized Campuses

In addition to the main campus at Wolgok-dong, Dongduk Women's University has specialized campus extensions located in areas where students can gain on-the-spot experience in their fields of study.

- **Design Research Center in Cheongdam-dong, the center of fashion** _ Located in Cheongdam-dong, the center of fashion, the Dongduk Women's University Design Research Center is equipped with practice rooms, studios, resource rooms, a fashion gallery, etc. and provides instruction to students on the latest fashion trends. Students can quickly understand and learn contemporary design trends since the center offers practical training programs such as assisting famous designers with their work as well as actively carrying out educational exchanges with other design institutes abroad.

- **Performing Arts Center in Daehakro, the mecca of performing arts** _ The Dongduk Women's University Performing Arts Center, a thirteen-story building equipped with studios, a performance testing theater, image practicing rooms, dance studios, seminar rooms, and a main auditorium with 450 seats, is often used for outside events such as television broadcasts and plays. As the center is located in Daehakro, the mecca of performing arts, students can conveniently understand trends in performing arts, while obtaining vivid on-the-spot Performing Arts Center in Daehakro, the mecca of performing arts.

- **Dongduk Art Gallery in Insa-dong, the center of art** _ The gallery, situated in Korea's leading art gallery neighborhood, is planning to hold temporary exhibitions on the trends and reality of world art as well as Korean art. It also upholds a good reputation for public service as it operates an art academy and hosts seminars to enhance exchanges among artists. The gallery enables art majors at Dongduk Women's University to possess a leading perspective in the world of art.

While trying to understand humanity through languages, history, knowledge and culture, the College of Humanities studies the basic principles of society and culture; helps students to better understand themselves and others and to overview nations and societies. The College of Humanities educates its students with specialized and extensive theoretical classes as well as on-the-spot training, enabling students to grow into refined intellectuals with sincere hearts. The college, consisting of the Department of Humanities and departments of foreign languages, allows students to select their majors after their freshmen year. In addition, the departments of foreign languages help talented students participate in international exchanges and learn foreign languages and cultures by offering language training programs as well as short-term and long-term study programs at sister universities

CREATIVE WRITING MAJOR

Students are asked to primarily write stories based on their insight. The objective is to create vivid stories by reorganizing and reinventing various aspects of life. Students can also learn creative writing skills from all genres through courses such as poetry, creative novel writing, understanding comedy writing, and movies & novels.

DEPARTMENT OF FRENCH

The Department of French supports students in obtaining a comprehensive understanding of the French language, literature, politics, economics, society, and culture. In particular, it allows students to contribute to the development of Korean culture and economy by helping them acquire an understanding of unique and various French ways of thinking and culture.

KOREAN LANGUAGE AND LITERATURE MAJOR

Students are taught to expand their linguistic abilities so that they may obtain a deeper understanding of the Korean language and express their opinions more precisely and logically. Specifically, students can enhance their understanding of contemporary and classical literature as well as hone their theoretical and practical writing skills.

DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH

The Department of English has an established curriculum which helps students enhance their English listening, speaking, reading and writing skills, with a focus on fluency in English speaking skills. In addition, it has intensified courses for students which teach them to freely utilize the English language in international society.

DEPARTMENT OF GERMAN

The Department of German educates its students to be able to effectively communicate with German native speakers in speaking and writing through well-structured German courses. In addition, it allows students to acquire a general knowledge of German culture and art with a variety of courses on German-speaking regions in the world.

KOREAN HISTORY MAJOR

Students study the development of Korean politics, economics, society, and culture from ancient times to modern day, enabling them to understand Korean cultural traditions through broad historical perspectives from Oriental to Western history, field investigations of historical remains, and on-the-spot practical training.

DEPARTMENT OF JAPANESE

The Department of Japanese has programs helping students research and analyze information written in Japanese and improve their Japanese speaking abilities. In particular, most students possess the JLPT level-1 speaking ability and have obtained a score over 280 in the Japanese university entrance examination.

DEPARTMENT OF CHINESE

The Department of Chinese helps its students to obtain basic Chinese speaking, reading, and writing skills and educates them to understand the lives of Chinese people and Chinese philosophies, so that students may better understand the Chinese language.

Warm Eyes towards the Economy, Society, and the World

Throughout history, the Social Sciences, which deals with society and economy, has been closely linked to human life and has developed through years of debate and research. The Department of Business Administration, Department of Economics, and Department of International Business of Dongduk Women's University foster women leaders with broad perspectives required in today's society by studying and teaching the theories and practices of business and economic activities. The Department of Library and Information Sciences studies theoretical and technical issues of information acquisition, processing, accumulation, searching and using; while the Department of Social Welfare focuses on fostering talented women who can contribute to establishing a welfare society where individuals can lead bountiful lives and where people can live in harmony. The Department of Child Development and Education offers practical educational programs in order to produce experts who research and act for the improvement of quality in children's lives.



DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

With its educational objectives of 'Creative Experts', 'Serving Members of Society', and 'Pioneering Citizens of the World', the Department of Business Administration supports students in acquiring strategic problem solving skills and effective resource management skills while understanding organization, human resources, production, finance, and accounting.

The Department of Computer Science offers intensified and specialized educational programs including several courses in data processing, while continuously providing updates on its curriculum based on technological developments and market situations, so that students can learn the skills desired by system development companies.



DEPARTMENT OF STATISTICS AND INFORMATION SCIENCE

The Department of Statistics and Information Science fosters data analysis professionals who can make reasonable decisions based on an enormous amount of data. It helps students establish a well-organized information system from various kinds of information obtained from a knowledge-based society, and teaches them to extract useful information through summarization, reorganization and analysis.

As a kind of applied science that contributes to the recovery and maintenance of public health, pharmacy is a complete life science that deals with life phenomena based on basic science such as physics, biology and chemistry, and studies physiological substances that affect such life phenomena. With its longstanding tradition, the College of Pharmacy has competent faculty, the Central Pharmaceutical Research Institute, and various laboratories with the most advanced facilities.

In particular, it provides students with various practical training programs, field trips to pharmaceutical companies and related industries, and medicinal plant collecting programs. It also offers special training practices in pharmacies, hospitals, pharmaceutical companies, and national/public institutes during winter and summer vacations. During summer vacations, the College also forms volunteer groups for public health consisting of alumni pharmacists, current students and faculty, providing their services to villages without medicinal access.



DEPARTMENT OF PHARMACY

The Department of Pharmacy was established in February 1955. A Dongduk Women's University alumna became the president of the Seoul Pharmaceutical Association in 2009, and another alumna was awarded the grand prize of Woman Pharmacist of the Year. The Department of Pharmacy focuses on fostering pharmacists who serve for public interest and who execute their duties in a creative and active manner in pharmacies, hospitals, pharmaceutical companies, and national/public institutes.



Color the World with the Delicate Echo of Emotions

The Arts are a product of human creativity and a pure act of self-expression to perpetuate an individual's vision of beauty and truth. The College of Arts offers a specialized and comprehensive curriculum in the arts and trains future musicians, artists, and curators. The College of Arts delivers a delicate echo of emotions to the world by fostering 1) professional craftswomen who can combine practicality and arts, and express it through a digital medium; 2) professional curators who not only understand various theories of art history, art criticism, and art discourse, but also possess practical skills in art museum studies, exhibition planning, and art management; 3) various members of art society who possess creative talent and an aesthetic sense; 4) and musicians whose natural abilities and musicianship are harmonious.



DEPARTMENT OF PAINTINGS

The Department of Paintings helps students to develop their potential as painters to the extent possible by providing comprehensive creativity tutoring and training courses on both Korean and Western paintings. In addition, with the Dongduk Art Gallery in Insa-dong, it provides students with various exhibition opportunities connected to the curriculum in a creative manner.

DEPARTMENT OF PIANO

Pianos can be used in almost every type of musical performance such as piano recitals, vocal music accompaniments, instrumental music accompaniments, ensembles, and orchestral music concertos. The Department of Piano with its international perspectives has produced world class pianists.



DEPARTMENT OF DIGITAL CRAFT ARTS

The Department of Digital Craft Arts aims to create beautiful environments by combining life and art. Particularly, the Department studies issues closely related to human lives as one of the characteristics of craft arts is the combination of life and art, and develops them through practices using a digital medium.

DEPARTMENT OF ORCHESTRAL INSTRUMENTS

The Department of Orchestral Instruments promotes an individual's ability to play musical instruments by practicing various genres of music from Baroque, Classical, Romantic to Modern. It also provides students with opportunities to hold regular orchestral concerts, string music concertos, pipe music concertos, and chamber music concertos.



DEPARTMENT OF CURATORIAL STUDIES AND ART MANAGEMENT

Offering the only 4 year degree program of its kind in South Korea, the Department of Curatorial Studies and Art Management develops students' abilities to plan high quality exhibitions and to create cultural arts of various genres as well as pure art with a balanced curriculum.

DEPARTMENT OF VOCAL MUSIC

The Department of Vocal Music provides individual tutoring of vocalization methods and vocal music techniques. It has a balanced curriculum consisting of theories and practices including vocal music literature, body training, vocal music ensemble, and chorus. In addition, it equips students with proper stage manners as singers by offering various stage opportunities such as operas and choruses.

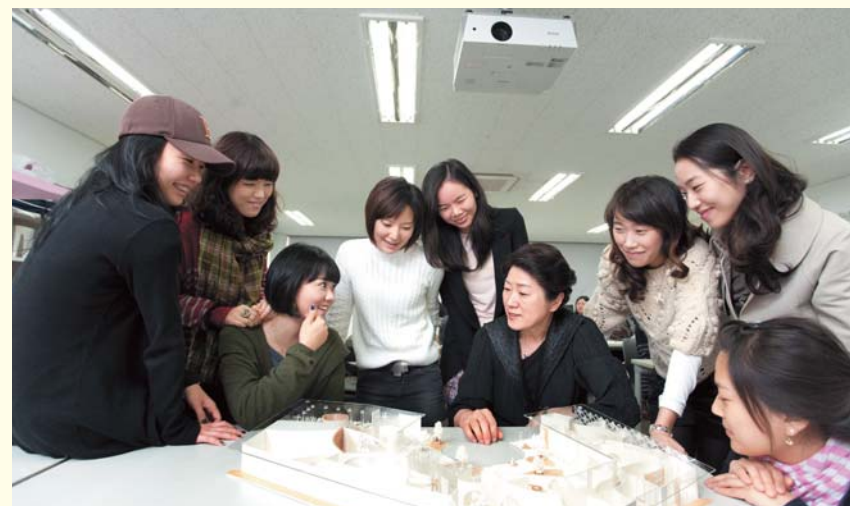
VISUAL COMMUNICATION & INTERIOR DESIGN MAJOR

DEPARTMENT OF DANCE

The Department of Dance offers various educational dance programs through its Performing Arts Center in Daehakro. In addition, it has a unique and specialized curriculum that includes traditional dance as well as modern dance.

DEPARTMENT OF MEDIA ARTS AND ENTERTAINMENT

Choon-Gang Academic Information Center
The Choon-Gang Academic Information Center is named after the pseudonym of the founder of Dongduk University, Dr. Cho, Dong-Shik. Students have access to the abundant information available at the Center, located in the back of the main campus with a total land area of approximately 400 m². In addition, it provides original data online through its integrated electronic library system.

Dongduk Women's Studies Center
The Dongduk Women's Studies Center was established to meet the long history of Dongduk Women's University as a women's university and to foster talented women to lead the world. The Women's Studies Library, located on the first and second floors of the five-story building, carries domestic and foreign books on women's studies, study rooms for graduate students, and a student's lounge. Meanwhile, the Korea Institute for Women, the University Museum where traditional artifacts are on display, and the Choongang Memorial Hall are located on the third, fourth, and fifth floors respectively.

Dongduk Women's Studies Library
The Dongduk Women's Studies Library was established in 1995 for the first time in South Korea to contribute to the development of women-related academic fields and to further enhance the specialty of a women's university. It possesses over 18,000 books and journals on women's studies as well as 1,000 non-written materials such as VTRs and CD-ROMs.

Multimedia Language Learning Center
The Multimedia Language Learning Center located in Sung-In Hall has 12 multimedia classrooms, a video conferencing room used for special lectures, and language laboratories. In addition, it has PC laboratories for multimedia classes and multimedia practice rooms for foreign language studies on



the sixth floor of the Hall. The multimedia practice room has WICOM devices for Audio Tape materials, and a DVD COMBO, monitors, and PCs for DVD and video materials. In addition, students may rent audio-visual materials in German, English, Japanese, Chinese, and French from the Center's office.

Central Instrument Laboratory
Consisting of an analysis instrument room, common instrument room, magnetic drive room, and experiment room, the Central Instrument Laboratory supports the research activities of faculty, graduate students and undergraduate students in the fields of pharmacy and natural sciences. It also possesses highly advanced equipment required for experiments in life sciences and analysis such as thermogravimetry, fluorescence microscopes, high-speed centrifugal separators, spectrometers, and elemental analyzers. It offers a suitable environment for experiments with its apparatus and materials.

Obesity Research Center
If you desire to lose weight gained during your studies, the Obesity Research Center can assist you. The center, an affiliated organization of the nation's first graduate schools in Obesity Science, provides systemic education through industrial-academic collaboration and practical training of weight management. It also offers diet programs to support students with obesity problems and various measurement & analysis services.

University Museum
Founded in 1977, the University Museum, with its unique identity as a museum in a women's university, has built a good reputation with its valuable collection of cultural heritage works. The Museum also closely collaborates with the Women's Studies Library in producing joint collections and research in the area of Women's Studies.



Dongduk Women's Newspaper
Founded in 1963, the campus newspaper has cultivated young talented reporters of broadcasting stations, the press, and publishing companies throughout its 45 year history. Currently, it publishes an 8 page (10 pages when necessary) biweekly newspaper. It is distributed to Dongduk Women's University alumni, middle/high schools, and university libraries as well as current students and university staff.

Dongduk Educational Broadcasting System
The Dongduk Educational Broadcasting System (DEBS), founded in 1958, has been awarded grand prizes and best broadcasting prizes at several major university broadcasting contests sponsored by KBS and MBC. In addition, a University Broadcasting Festival is held each year to help students understand how the broadcasting system operates. DEBS also serves as an important stage for amateur producers to introduce their work through an annual event called the 'Castle of Mobius' with programs such as the Mokhwa(cotton flower) DJ Competition, the Broadcasting Work Competition, etc.

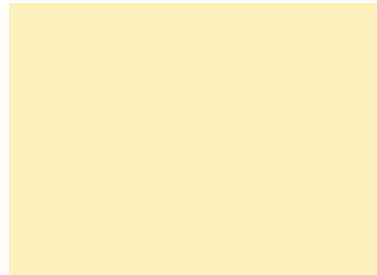
